Sarah Bagley, M.D. is an Assistant Professor of Medicine and Pediatrics at Boston University School of Medicine and an Attending Physician in General Internal Medicine and Pediatrics at Boston Medical Center. Dr. Bagley attended Georgetown University School of Medicine, and completed the Combined Internal Medicine and Pediatrics Residency at Brown University and an Addiction Medicine Fellowship at Boston University School of Medicine. She is the founder and Medical Director of CATALYST, a clinical program at Boston Medical Center that provides integrated substance use care and primary care for patients less than 25 years old. Dr. Bagley has received funding from the National Institute on Drug Abuse to conduct research about engagement in treatment and overdose prevention of young adults after nonfatal opioid overdose.
